7. CURRENT PRIORITY INITIATIVE: 100 CHILDREN, ONE GREATER FUTURE

IRF is beginning its education sponsorship effort with a focused goal of supporting 100 children during the current school year. The initiative is designed to help children from vulnerable backgrounds remain in school and have the basic resources needed to learn with dignity.

Sponsorship target: 100 children

Estimated support per child: US\$175

Total fundraising goal: US\$17,500

Support includes: school fees, uniform/clothing, books, and learning materials.

The 100-child initiative represents the beginning of IRF's broader education and empowerment journey. As capacity and partnerships grow, the Foundation intends to expand its reach and deepen the quality and sustainability of its programs.
